

#### Can cement tiles be placed in the kitchen?

The use of cement tiles as a kitchen floor is not a problem.

The kitchen is usually used more intensively than the other rooms in your house, but the proper treatment of the cement tiles prevents many problems.

The top layer of our cement tiles is a few millimetres thick, so they can take quite a pounding.

Our wide range of cement tiles ensures that there is always a suitable cement tile available that will give your kitchen just that little bit more character. Whether your home is classic, or ultramodern.





#### Cement tiles in the bathroom

The colourful patterns of a cement tile come to their true right also in a bathroom.

However, make sure to see to a good impregnation.

It must be noted that the cement tiles may have to be treated a bit more than usual, if you use them in damp conditions, but their charming appearance will make it worth your while.

#### Origin of cement tiles

Long ago, the Moors brought the technique for cement tiles to Europe, after which the Spaniards and the Portuguese shared it with the whole world.

Have you fallen for the charm of cement tiles? Great! Cement tiles have the unique characteristic of setting a typical mood, which no other tile can hold a candle to.

Now that you have made a decision, we will definitely not leave you out in the cold. We will be happy to provide you with some tips regarding:





#### **Placement**

Cement tiles must be placed on a flat, dry and clean surface. Moisture that is still present causes stains on the surface of the tile.

Leave enough space up to the finished floor 5mm for the glue so that you can work with a 10mm equalizing comb. Apply strong, flexible tile adhesive on the ground and on the back of the tiles.

Place tiles with the hand-no hammer-with a small joint (1 to 2 mm).

If you would like to decorate an area with cement tiles, then you should especially keep the width of the surface in mind, because the width of a space is a reference point; after all, you do not want to end up with half a drawing. So, you must always start with the laying of cement tiles from the middle of a room.

It is recommended to make a drawing beforehand so that you can already know then how your drawing will end up regarding the width; the length plays a smaller "optical" role.

#### Grouting

Never use coloured grout. The tiles can absorb the pigment and it cannot be removed anymore. Fill the joints with a rubber grout squeegee. The excess grout should be removed immediately with a sponge and cloth. Never use acidic products to remove grout haze. They damage the surface of the tiles.

#### **Impregnation**

Considering that cement tiles are porous, it is recommended to protect the surface against penetration from dirt and stains

Cement tiles are often impregnated before placement, but that is certainly not the rule. Impregnation prevents the penetration of grout haze into the porous surface of the tiles during installation.

The disadvantage of this, however, is that after removal of the grout haze afterwards, this impregnation should be done once again. This can sometimes be rather labour intensive and expensive.

**Im-pregna** is a solvent solution that prevents water and oil from penetrating the tiles.

Im-pregna is a one-off impregnation, you will provide the cement tiles with an immediate and permanent protection against stains and water. Take note, acid stains are unavoidable.

The appearance of the tiles almost never changes.

Im-pregna will, however, give your tile a slight darkening. The tile remains matt, but is protected.

Im-pregna is to be applied with a brush on a dry, clean floor and wipe afterwards with a dry cloth.

Do not use too much, otherwise the excess will dry on the tiles and you will end up with stripes.

Do a test on one tile so you can see how much the tiles absorb.

By treating the tile with **Protect II,** you accelerate the natural saturation process. A nutritional natural soap can afterwards complete the saturation process (lasting for approximately three months).





#### Maintenance

Clean with a neutral soap that is suitable for calcareous natural stone. Never use strong detergents, acidic or chlorine products.

Stubborn stains can be removed with a scotch&brite abrasive scouring pad and/or a solvent. Intensively used floors in bars, shops, restaurants, etc. These floors require a special treatment. **Carosol** is a customised product, you offer your cement tiles years of protection and a pleasant

maintenance.



#### Cleaning

Clean the tiles with clean water after placement. You will remove the thin layer of pigment powder that may still be present on the surface. Important, clean only one square meter at a time. Use very clean water.

#### If grout has presented.

After insertion, you can remove the remaining grout haze with **Cena**. This remover is specially designed for calcareous tiles and must be used very accurately.

The best result will be obtained when you first treat one tile with undiluted product and then the tile next to it diluted with the dosage indicated on the bottle. The result must be the same, if not, the proportion must be adjusted.

Make sure each time that you do not treat large areas in one go. The product must be spread evenly over the tiles.



#### If there is no grout haze present.

For a thorough cleaning of your cement tiles after removing the grout haze, or if there was no grout haze present, it is best to use **Piraat**.


Piraat removes all severe contamination. It is also best to treat one tile with undiluted product and to rinse it thoroughly and then the tile next to it with the proportion as indicated on the bottle.

If the result is good, you can treat the entire floor. Take note to never treat large areas in one go.










3D - Patchwork - Cubic Hex - 200 X 230 X 16 mm - 5470






Triangle - Patchwork - 340 X 340 X 16 mm
